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DESCRIPTION: In this activity you will research a social studies topic and add 2-3 different types of slides for students to participate on their own devices during a class session.

AMOUNT OF TIME: 10-15 minutes

Internet for research

OBJECTIVE(S):

1. The creator will be able to convert research into an interactive question.
2. The creator will utilize multimodal representation to assess topical information.
3. The creator will create a QR code for other users to access the lesson.

STEPS TO COMPLETE THE ACTIVITY:



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1. Choose a Social Studies topic to research 3 facts using the internet. (civics, government, economics, state history, U.S. history, world history, local community)
2. Open Google Chrome.
3. Open a new Google Slide Presentation
4. Access the Google Chrome Store to add the PearDeck extension and the QR Code extension.
5. Load the PearDeck Add On via the extension's menu
6. Create informational slides and question slides for the 3 social studies facts using three different types of questions.
7. Share the Lesson:
 - a. Click the green "Start Lesson" button
 - b. Choose either Instructor led to participate together or choose Student Paced to allow students to participate on their own.
 - c. Copy the "Join Link"
 - d. Access the QR code chrome extension
 - e. Paste the presentation link into the QR Code Generator
 - f. Share the QR code with table mates to quiz each other
8. Share with the Conference Participants
 - a. Once the slide presentation is complete, copy the share link
 - b. Copy and paste the QR Code to the Group Presentation to share after the conference.

VOCABULARY:

QR Code - a machine-readable code consisting of an array of black and white squares, typically used for storing URLs or other information for reading by the camera on a smartphone

Multimodal - Multimodal projects are simply projects that have multiple "modes" of communicating a message. For example, while traditional papers typically only have one mode (text), a multimodal project would include a combination of text, images, motion, or audio.



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EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:
